Non-U.S. citizens must report a change of address by completing the **Change of Address Form** and submitting it to OIA. If you are not in the Houston area, you may fax or scan this form to your International Visitor Advisor (IVA); however, please mail the original to OIA using the address at the bottom of this form. Reporting a change of address to OIA does not update your address in UTLINK or the school or department in which you study or work. Please report your current address to the appropriate school or program sponsor in addition to notifying OIA.
