Important disbursement facts to note:

- Students must be enrolled half-time for loans to disburse. Academic students must be enrolled for both 6-week summer sessions at the start of the summer term to be considered for financial aid.
- The 4th class day denotes the end of the add/drop summer period
- All HOLDS must be resolved prior to loan disbursement
- Entrance Counseling and Loan Agreement (MPN) must be completed on studentloans.gov



Public Service Loan Forgiveness

Student loan borrowers working for government organizations, Not-for-profit establishments -501 (c) (3), and other authorized businesses may be eligible to participate in the Public Service Loan Forgiveness (PSLF) program. The PSLF program forgives the remaining balance on your Federal Direct Student loans after you have made 120 qualifying monthly payments under a qualifying monthly repayment plan while working full-time time for a qualifying employer.

ANTICIPATED GRADUATES

Students preparing to graduate who received Federal or Institutional loans must complete Loan Exit Counseling prior to graduation. Anticipated graduates required to meet this obligation will receive an email from our [Loan Department](#) with instructions for completing the Loan Exit Counseling process.

HPSL & LDS

The Loans for Disadvantaged Students and Health Professions Student Loan programs provide long term, low interest rate loans to Professional students enrolled full-time in the Medical and Doctor of Dental Surgery (DDS) programs. Qualifying students click [here](#) to apply.

Year-Round Pell

Pell grants are available year round starting 2018. Students may receive up to 150% of their scheduled Pell award each year. To qualify, students must be enrolled half-time (6 hrs) to receive additional Pell.
